
Pathway Bark is brown in color and 1/4"-1.5" in size.

GENERAL USE INSTRUCTIONS:

Elevate the beauty and functionality of your garden beds and pathways with our Pathway Bark. Begin by thoroughly clearing the area of weeds, debris, and any edging stones or borders you plan to replace later. Spread the bark evenly with a rake, aiming for a 2-4-inch depth to suppress weeds. After spreading, use the rake to create a smooth, level layer, but avoid piling bark directly against plant stems or edging to prevent smothering. To maintain this attractive and effective application, replenish the bark layer annually or as needed.


